- 2. Labeled "cervicel lymph node, right neck (frozen section)": The specimen consists of a 1.2 cm soft pink ten lymph node which is bisacted, the larger half frozen and embedded as 2FSA, the smaller half embedded with 2FSA with permanent sections (smaller haif not frozen).
- INTRAOPERATIVE CONSULTATION (F5): Lymph node showing some suggestion of: architectural effacement. - Diagnosis pending study of permanent sections.
- 3. Labeled "deep cervical lymph node, right nack": The specimen consists of a 2.5 cm firm fleshy tan node having smooth fleshy cut surfaces. Tissue sant for culture, tissue sent for flow cytometric immunophenotyping analysis, and remaining tissue is fixed in 85 for histologic study.

## MICRO EXAMINATION:

Permanent sections reveal a low grade non Hodgkin's lymphoma similar to this patient's previous intestinal lymphoma (S-1277-91). Subtle differences from the previous intestinal lymphoma include mild sclerosis within the centers of several of the neoplastic follicles, and a mild but definite increase in the percentage of large calls. Small cleaved lymphoid cells still comprise the marjority of the neoplestic cellular elements.
